



EARLY BIRD SHOOT, ISLAND BAY, 6.00 am Saturday 4 May.

Participants who have not brought their own cars or found a ride with friends and colleagues will be allocated transport by volunteers from the organising committee.

We will then leave the Town Hall car park and head to the south coast at Island Bay via Taranaki Street, Vivian Street, Kent Terrace, around the Basin Reserve onto Adelaide Road which will take us straight through suburban Newtown and Island Bay to the coast.

At Island Bay the small fishing fleet bobs in the sheltered waters like Rita Angus's well known painting, waves smash against the rocks to the south of Tapu te Ranga Island and mist and sea spray rise up over the cliffs illuminated by the rising sun.

You will be left to your own devices but volunteers from the organising committee will be available to offer advice and directions.

When you have had enough, rejoin your car pool and retrace your route back to the Town Hall area in time for breakfast and a hot drink at one of the nearby cafés (at your own cost) before the PSNZ AGM at 8.30 am. There are no cafés close to the waterfront at Island Bay The closest are the Bach café a little along the coast to the west which does not open until 8.00 am and service can be slow. The Maranui café, right on the water front at Lyall Bay to the east, opens at 7.00 am.
