



## Kapiti Island Full Day Field Trip

Assemble at the Town hall at 7.15 to board your green Newlands bus on Wakefield Street opposite the Amora Hotel.

On loading you will be checked against the participant's list to ensure that we have a Department of Conservation permit for you. The bus will then depart for Paraparaumu Beach via the Ngauranga Gorge, the urban motorway through Tawa and Porirua, along the edge of the Porirua Harbour and the coastal highway at Paekakariki to arrive at Paraparaumu Beach at about 8.30 am. At the Kapiti Boating Club your bags and clothing will undergo a biosecurity search for rodents, seeds or other unwanted nasties then you will board the boat for Kapiti Island. The boat is boarded on the beach before a tractor backs it into the water so you will not get your feet wet.

Once on the island you will receive an introductory briefing over morning tea and have a guided walk where we will learn about the natural and human history of the island. You then have about 5 hours for independent exploration and photography before the ferry takes as back to our bus at Paraparaumu Beach.

The trip will go to the northern end of the island where the bush is more open and thus bird viewing and photography is easier. Photo opportunities include the lagoon and the coast as well as in the bush.

There will be an opportunity to catch up with some of our overseas speakers who are coming on this trip. A representative from Canon may have a selection of lenses for Canon users to try.

Morning tea and lunch are provided. Shelter and toilets are available
