

WELLINGTON CITY PHOTOWALK - Half Day Field Trip, Afternoon

This walk starts at the Town Hall after lunch and follows the wharves before crossing to Post Office Square opposite Queens Wharf and heading along Panama Street to the Cable Car terminal off Lambton Quay.

We take the Cable Car to Kelburn (free if you have a gold card) where there are opportunities to photograph the views over the City before taking one of the many routes down hill through the Botanical Gardens to the Rose Garden and Begonia House. From here we walk through the historic Bolton Street Cemetery to the Mortuary Chapel before heading back to the Town Hall via the Terrace and Lambton Quay.

Detailed maps of the Botanic Garden and Bolton Street Cemetery showing some of the highlights are available from the tour guides.

TIME TABLE

Depart Wellington Town Hall	13.00
Walk to Cable Car via Queens Wharf, Post Office Square and Cable Car to Botanic Gardens (at own cost)	
Depart Cable Car to walk through Gardens to Begonia House	13.30
Depart Begonia House / Rose Garden	15.00
Arrive Bolton Street Cemetery	15.05
Walk through Cemetery to Bolton Street	
Leave Mortuary Chapel at Bolton St entrance to Cemetery	16.00
Return to Town Hall via Bolton St, The Terrace, Lambton Quay, Post Office Square and Queens Wharf.	
Arrive Wellington Town Hall, Tour ends	17.00

Notes:

- Parts of this walk are up and down hill and there are some steps but the tour guides will be able to direct walkers to gentler routes
- Participants are free to leave the walks at any point to return to their hotels or linger at areas of particular interest although please tell your guides if you do intend to leave the group
